Artist blacksmith Allan Kress will demonstrate using common steel to make uncommon art pieces. His creative use of angle iron, channel iron, tubing and pipe will open new avenues of thought about how to approach your artistic projects. These pieces will use modern and traditional techniques.

Monday January 12, 2015

Instructor Allison Bohorfoush will teach a beginning to intermediate copper class. Another pattern will be offered as well as this one.

Skills to be learned include; straight line chiseling, butchering, grain and line texture, layering and repose'.

In this class you will learn the theory behind repose' work, how and when to anneal the metal, how to approach a particular pattern and why, over—under work and the importance of which comes first.

Tools for class will be supplied by the instructor. You will be able to purchase them after class if desired.

Also available for purchase are blanchard ground steel plates, urethane, UHMW, hammers, chisels, Live of Sulfur, 0000 steel wool.
