The workshop portion will be limited to approximately 20 active participants depending on how many anvils we have, however the presentation and IITH are open to all as is watching the workshop. The event will run from 9am – 4:30pm-ish both days.

## A few words about the demonstrator: Pete Renzetti

Pete is a highly accomplished blacksmith and metal worker. He is one of the founding members of the Artist Blacksmith Association of North America (ABANA). He was a major part of the Yellin works. If you attend the Gichner Hammer-In, Pete is there making "Puddle People" and giving advice. He has been a demonstrator at many of the ABANA conferences with cohorts building intricate things like a door knocker and a coffee grinder. He wants you to bring your project questions, problems, and/or difficulties to the Joint meeting and he will try to find a solution.
