The 2022 Joint Meeting at Furnace Town 26 & 27 March 2022

Hosted by the Furnace Town Blacksmiths Guild (FTBG) & the Mid-Atlantic Smiths Association (MASA)

Both Saturday and Sunday will be a half-day demonstration of projects from beginner to beginning intermediate and then a half-day hands-on workshop supervised by Dale.

We will have Iron-in-the-Hat (IITH) on Saturday, so bring an item or two.

The registration cost is \$ 60 per person. After 21 March the cost per person is \$ 80.

The cost includes coffee & donuts each morning and a catered lunch each noon.

Supper on Saturday will be in a local restaurant but is not included in the cost. We plan on having a slide show on Saturday either before or after supper. The workshop portion will be limited to approximately 20 active participants depending on how many anvils we have, however the presentation and IITH are open to all as is watching the workshop. You are encouraged to bring your tools and, as anvils are in short supply, an anvil with stand. Space for tailgating is available. If you wish to tailgate, let Mark know ahead of time, please.

The event will run from 9am – 4:30pm-ish both days.
