The workshop portion will be limited to approximately 20 active participants depending on how many anvils we have, however the presentation and IITH are open to all as is watching the workshop. You are encouraged to bring your tools and, as anvils are in short supply, an anvil with stand. Space for tailgating is available. If you wish to tailgate, let Mark know ahead of time, please.

The event will run from 9am - 4:30pm-ish both days.
